

CLASS RANK

The Board authorizes a system of class ranking, by grade point average, for students in grade(s) 9-12.

Students entering the high school from non-chartered or home-based schooling shall have no established grade point average (GPA) or class rank for purposes of graduation honors until such time as they have completed four (4) semesters.

All students who graduate from Cuyahoga Falls High School through 2015 are ranked according to the average accumulative grade, which they have achieved during high school. This rank becomes a part of the permanent record of each graduate and is a part of each student's official transcript of grades. The rank is computed at the end of the junior year and a final rank at the completion of the senior year. Beginning with the class of 2016, students will have the opportunity to be recognized through a Laude System. All students with a cumulative GPA of 4.0 or higher will be recognized as a Summa Cum Laude designation. Students earning a final cumulative GPA of 3.6 to 3.999 will be recognized as Magna Cum Laude and students with a final GPA of 3.4 to 3.599 will be recognized as Cum Laude.
