## PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT IN EDUCATION

The Board believes that parent/guardian involvement is an important part of the educational program. Therefore, all parents/guardians of students enrolled in the District are encouraged to take an active role in the education of their children. In order to ensure that this policy is followed, the Board directs the Superintendent to:

- A. Encourage strong home-school partnerships;
- B. Provide for consistent and effective communication between the parents/guardians and school officials;
- C. Offer parents/guardians ways to assist and encourage their children to do their best;
- D. Offer ways parents/guardians can support classroom learning activities;
- E. Provide opportunities for parents/guardians to be involved in the parental involvement program; and
- F. Encourage parents to express ideas, concerns, and judgments about the schools through such means as (1) written suggestion(s) or proposal(s); (2) presentations at hearings; (3) responses to surveys made through interviews, written instruments, or other means; (4) comments at meetings of the Board; and (5) service on citizens' advisory committees.

Parent volunteers in the schools are also encouraged under the direction of the building principal.
