

### **DRIVER EDUCATION**

The Toronto Board of Education has entered into a contract with a commercial driver training school in an effort to continue to meet state standards of providing quality driver education instruction for our students and to reduce the cost of providing this training which will result in considerable savings to the School District.

The guidelines which are now applicable are as follows:

- A. No classroom instruction or road training will be scheduled during the regular school day.
- B. Classroom instruction classes will be offered on an as needed basis when a minimum number of students as prescribed by the commercial school have registered for the classroom instruction.
- C. Road training will be arranged by the commercial school as students are available on the basis of having attained the proper age and completed classroom instruction prerequisites.
- D. Whenever possible, the instructors for classroom instruction will be selected from among the properly certificated/licensed persons who are currently employed by the Toronto City School District.
- E. A fee which will be established annually will be assessed each student who enrolls for driver training. This fee will be payable during the first three (3) days of classroom instruction. Failure to pay this fee within the three-day period may result in the removal of that student from the class.
- F. Upon entry into driver training class each student will complete and have signed by a parent or guardian a registration/parental consent form. This form contains information for certificate completion as well as vital information regarding class attendance and the implications of failing driver training.
