

**JOINT BUSINESS ADVISORY COUNCIL  
AND FAMILY AND CIVIC ENGAGEMENT TEAM**

The Board directs the Superintendent to select individuals to serve on a joint Business Advisory Council and Family and Civic Engagement Team. The Council/Team shall include parents, community representatives, health and human services representatives, business representatives, and other individuals determined to be appropriate by the Superintendent.

The Council/Team shall fulfill the following duties:

- A. Advise and provide recommendations to the Board on matters including but not limited to: (1) the delineation of employment skills and the development of curriculum to instill these skills; (2) changes in the economy and in the job market; (3) the types of employment in which future jobs are most likely to be available; and (4) suggestions for developing a working relationship among businesses, labor organizations and educational personnel in the district;
  - 1. The Council and the Board shall develop a plan by which the Council shall advise the Board about those matters, identified above, and shall file such plan with the Ohio Department of Education. The Council shall meet with the Board at least quarterly.
  - 2. The Council and the Board shall file a joint statement, not later than March 1 of each school year, describing how the District and the Council have fulfilled their responsibilities pursuant to O.R.C. §3313.82 and this policy.
- B. Work with the local Family and Children First Council (FCFC) to provide recommendations to the Board regarding qualifications and responsibilities to be included in job descriptions for a family and civic engagement coordinator;
- C. Develop a five-year family and civic engagement plan;
- D. Provide an annual progress report on the development and implementation of the five-year plan for the Board to submit to the FCFC; and
- E. Advise and provide recommendations on any other matter specified by the Board.
