

TUTORING STUDENTS FOR PROFIT

No teaching employee shall tutor a Tomorrow Center student for profit, without first obtaining the prior written consent of the Executive Director. If permitted by the Executive Director, the following conditions apply to a teacher who is tutoring a Tomorrow Center student for profit:

- A. No tutoring shall occur during the regular school day or during the regular working hours of the teacher.
- B. The teacher's use of School facilities for purposes of tutoring students for profit must conform to Board Policy governing Community Use of School Facilities, including the payment of any associated fee or charge for such use.
- C. No teacher shall tutor, for profit, a Tomorrow Center student who is enrolled in the teacher's class.
