

SCREENING OF BEGINNING PUPILS

A pupil who is entering kindergarten or first grade for the first time and is entering for the first time at the School, must be properly screened for any medical or health problems, as well as though relating to hearing, vision, speech, and communications, and health or medical problems, and for any developmental disorders. The cost for such screening shall be paid by the parents.

Any parent may provide the School with a written statement indicating that he or she does not wish to have his or her child screened.

Prior to the first day of August of the school year in which a pupil is required to be screened, the School shall provide parents with information about individuals and/or organizations that provide screening services in the community.
