

BOARD - STAFF COMMUNICATIONS

The Board of Education desires to maintain open channels of communication between itself and the staff; however, the basic line of communication will be through the Superintendent. Therefore, all official policies, directives, and communications related to staff members shall be communicated by the Superintendent and not directly from individual Board members.

Board members having concerns about the day-to-day operations of the District and the duties assigned to individual staff members shall communicate solely with the Superintendent so as to avoid employee allegations of intimidation, conflicting directives, and interference with labor relations.

Staff members are not prohibited from contacting Board members but are encouraged to direct their concerns through the Superintendent for resolution.

Concerns regarding day-to-day operations and regarding various duties should be directed to the Superintendent.

Visits to Schools

Individual Board members may be interested in visiting schools on occasion for a variety of purposes that could be subject to misinterpretation by staff members. Therefore, Board members shall inform the Superintendent in advance of the purpose of such planned visits and shall make arrangements with the building principal for the visit. Official visits by Board members require authorization of the Board.
