LATCHKEY PROGRAMS (WE CARE)

Before instituting a latchkey program, the Superintendent shall notify parents and other interested parties that the Board is considering participating in the provision of latchkey programs. The Board will accept public input on the Board's decision whether or not to participate, as well as any other decisions concerning the District's role in the implementation and funding of any latchkey programs if the Board does decide to participate.

Pupils shall be admitted pursuant to the following rules:

- A. Parent(s) or guardian(s) must clearly identify the days the student is expected to be enrolled in the program.
- B. Payment for Latchkey services must be made in a timely manner.
- C. Every student enrolled in the program is expected to follow the rules for behavior. Students who continually deviate from the rules may be asked to withdraw from the program.

Those fees or tuition charged by the Board must be deposited into a special fund designated to receive such funds. Money will not be expended from the general fund except as permitted to state law.
