

MARRIED AND PREGNANT STUDENTS

Marital, maternal or paternal status shall not affect the rights and privileges of students to receive a public education nor to take part in any program or activity offered by the School District.

Married students under the age of eighteen (18) are subject to the compulsory school attendance laws and are required to attend school unless excused in accordance with law.

Married or unmarried pregnant students shall not be excluded from school. However, a married or unmarried pregnant student may be excused from school in the advanced stages of pregnancy when, in the judgment of a physician and/or designee and/or the Superintendent of Schools or designee, such attendance would be detrimental to the safety and well being of the student.

A pregnant married or unmarried student may be provided alternate programs of instruction such as home tutoring. Efforts will be made to ensure that the educational program of the student is disrupted as little as possible, and that she is encouraged to return to high school after the birth of her baby and complete requirements for graduation.
