Cuyahoga Falls City School District Board of Education Policy Manual Chapter IX – Community Relations

BUSINESS ADVISORY COUNCIL

The Superintendent shall and the Board may appoint members to a Business Advisory Council. This Council shall develop a plan, to advise and provide recommendations to the Board, on matters specified by the Board, including but not limited to:

- 1) The delineation of employment skills;
- 2) The development of curriculum needed to instill such skills;
- 3) Changes in the economy;
- 4) Changes in the job market, and the types of jobs most likely to be available; and
- 5) Ideas or suggestions for developing a working relationship among businesses, labor organizations, and educational personnel.

The Council may consist of up to 11 members including the Superintendent, Treasurer and two board members appointed by the Board President to serve as the Board's Representatives.

This Council shall meet as many times during the calendar year as it deems necessary. However, the Council shall meet with the full Board at least once every quarter to update the Board on this Council's progress. A joint statement between the Board and the Council, describing how the Board and the Council are fulfilling their responsibilities under Ohio law, shall be filed with the Ohio Department of Education no later than March 1 of each calendar year.

Meetings of the Business Advisory Council to the Board fall under the auspices of the Ohio Open Meetings Act. The Council shall notice its meetings and take minutes. Meeting notices and minutes shall be posted on the Board of Education website and in the *Falls News Press*.
