

PAGERS AND OTHER ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS DEVICES

Students are prohibited from carrying pocket pagers and other electronic communications devices in any school building or on any grounds or premises of the District. A student will be permitted to carry a pocket pager or other electronic communications device if the student's parent or guardian submits a written request that the student carry such a device, and the request is approved by the student's building principal.

For the purposes of this policy, a "pocket pager" means any device that can be carried by a person, that is capable of receiving a radio signal or other telecommunications signal, and that emits a signal upon receipt of a radio or other telecommunications signal. An "electronic communications" device means any device that is powered by batteries or electricity and that is capable of receiving, transmitting communications from or to a person.

A student who violates this policy shall be subject to discipline including suspension and/or expulsion.
