

FACULTY COUNCILS

The Board recognizes the importance of communication in school buildings. The building administrators, under the general direction of the Superintendent, will organize in their schools a Faculty Council whose membership shall be elected or selected by the general staff members of the individual school. Membership should remain small enough so each council can function effectively.

The purpose of a faculty council is to advise the building administrator regarding any matters affecting the school, particularly those dealing with improvement of instruction and faculty morale.

It is the responsibility of a council to keep the staff informed of council activities and/or functions.
