

STUDENT MEAL CHARGES

The Board desires to allow children to receive the nutrition they need to stay focused during the school day, minimize identification of children with insufficient funds to pay for school meals, and maintain the financial integrity of the District's food service account.

Students may charge any combination of meals up to a negative balance of \$5.00 for grades K-5 and \$6.00 for grades 6-12. When a negative balance of \$5.00 for grades K-5 and \$6.00 for grades 6-12 is reached, the parents/guardians/custodians of the student will be contacted by the District and an alternative meal and milk will be provided to the student until the entire negative balance is paid in full. With the exception of milk, students may only purchase snack or ala carte items with cash if they have a positive account balance.

The District shall communicate regularly with the parents of students regarding collection of a negative meal balance of \$5.00 for grades K-5 and \$6.00 for grades 6-12.

This policy is to be provided in writing to all households at the start of each school year and to households transferring to the District during the school year. A copy of this policy shall also be provided to all District staff responsible for its enforcement.
