

TUTORING FOR PAY

No teacher may tutor for pay a student who is a member of his/her class. Tutorial assistance to students is considered a normal responsibility of the teacher except in extenuating circumstances.

A teacher may tutor other students for pay only in accordance with the following conditions.

- A. Tutoring is done after the regular school day and not on school premises unless special exceptions are approved by the Superintendent.
- B. Tutoring must have the approval of the principal and must be in accordance with district requirements and guidelines.
